



HEAL International responds to local priorities by building on strengths and providing opportunities through the support of education, health initiatives and leadership development.

Child education sponsorships

The child sponsorship program provides education to children that may not have the opportunity to attend school and places them on a path towards a brighter future.

- HEAL sponsors directly supported 13 primary and secondary school students
- Additional donations this year also supported the equivalent of 6 additional students through Y.E.S. Uganda.



Post-secondary scholarship fund

HEAL is currently supporting four students through their post-secondary or vocational training:

- Nicholas is an enrolled apprentice studying bricklaying
- Geoffrey is in his first year of a three year clinical officer program
- James is studying to become a medical laboratory assistant
- Moses (2010 recipient) is continuing in his nursing program after achieving top standing in his first year



Youth Encouragement Services (YES)

Our ongoing partnership with YES helps support health improvement and programs that promote agricultural skills to encourage independence and food security. These programs support children living in their communities as well as those living at the Manna rescue home for HIV+ orphans. This year \$2000 from HEAL donors went directly towards supporting the daily health and needs of these orphans.



Global citizenship

We endeavor to strengthen the quality of education in remote rural schools in Uganda through engaged partnerships and leadership development with schools in Canada.

- Old Scona High School has taken on the challenge of supporting Kakooga and Rugaaga primary schools raising money for the following supplies in the past year
 - 456 textbooks
 - 10 soccer balls
 - >100 homework packages
- We are looking for other schools interested in this type of partnership
