Child education sponsorships

The child sponsorship program provides education to children that may not have the opportunity to attend school and places them on a path towards a brighter future.

- HEAL sponsors directly supported 12 primary and secondary school students
- Additional donations of \$21,700 covered partial education costs for 300 students supported by YES Uganda



Post-secondary scholarship fund

HEAL supported 7 students through their post-secondary or vocational training:

- Geoffrey and Bright are enrolled in the Medical Officer of Health Program
- James is studying to become a Medical Laboratory Assistant
- Nabila enrolled in The Kagando School of Nursing and Midwifery
- Moses graduated from a 3-year nursing program at the top of his class
- Nicholas graduated from his apprenticeship as a bricklayer



Youth Encouragement Services (YES) Uganda

Our ongoing partnership with YES helps support health improvement and programs that promote agricultural skills to encourage independence and food security. These programs support children living in their communities as well as those living at the Manna rescue home for HIV+ orphans.



Global citizenship

We endeavor to strengthen the quality of education in remote rural schools in Uganda through engaged partnerships and leadership development with schools in Canada.
