HEAL International responds to local priorities in Uganda by providing opportunities through the support of education, health initiatives, and leadership development.

Child education sponsorships

The child sponsorship program provides primary and secondary-level education opportunities to children who would not otherwise have the opportunity to attend school. This year:

- HEAL sponsors directly supported 11 orphaned and vulnerable children to get an education.
- Additional donations of \$11,000 covered costs of tuition and school supplies for 300 orphaned and vulnerable children supported by YES Uganda.

Post-secondary scholarships

HEAL scholarships have helped 4 students complete post-secondary training to date. There are currently 11 Scholarship Recipients:

- 8 are nursing students with one graduating the end of 2014, 2 are studying law in Uganda's top law school, and 1 is completing his Medical Officer of Health program in 2015.
- On average, scholarship students require \$1200 to 1500 per year. The nursing programs are mostly 2.5 years, while other programs require 3 to 4 years for completion.
- In 2014, HEAL disbursed \$15,750 in support of scholarship students.

School partnerships

Since 2010, we have worked with high schools in Edmonton and Calgary to partner with primary schools in Uganda. In 2014:

- Students at Old Scona Academic and Henry Wise Wood High School raised over \$15,400 to purchase textbooks, practice exams and school books for Kakooga, Rugaaga and Kyakayomba Primary Schools.
- A new rain harvesting water tank was installed in Kakooga Primary School.
- We began to work with students at the University of Alberta and University of Calgary to help improve and expand these school partnerships.

- Students currently have to walk between 10 to 25kms per day to attend school.
- The land has been donated and the community will donate labour and local building materials.
- Construction needs to start immediately so that the land is not returned for other projects.
